Bareroot harvesting began on our Willowbend Nursery farm more than a century ago. Today, the same tried-and-true production method remains in place, optimized and improved by our commitment to using advanced technology and innovations to produce and ship the highest quality bareroot stock.

### But what makes Willowbend bareroot special?

**Liners & Soil** | Our growers firmly believe that the best plants start with high-quality liners, planted in the sandy-loam soils of our farms, grown in a region recognized for being among the most productive and fruitful in North America.

**Cycle Trimming** | Throughout the growing season, young trees and shrubs destined to be harvested in fall as bareroot plants are trimmed at precise intervals, resulting in more substantial, vegetative growth and a more consistent, high-quality product.

**Technology & Innovation** | Our farms have invested in advanced, bareroot harvesting equipment that shrinks the bareroot harvest timeline substantially, resulting in higher quality. Additionally, our climate-controlled grading barns ensure quality is preserved throughout the winter storage period and into the spring shipping season.







## 1-DAY SHIPPING

Our location in **Northeast Ohio** is within one day's shipping time (500 miles) of roughly 50% of the U.S. population. This helps our customers save on currently historic freight and transportation costs. Our loading crews can fit on average 4,000-5,000 hydrangea tree whips on a single truck, or in the case of shrubs, 2,500 (depending on size/grade).

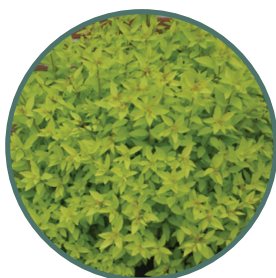
